

Transitional Guidelines for Fishing

Revision Date: April 24, 2020

Introduction:

Fishing is permitted at the following locations on a transitional basis per the guidelines provided below.

- Berry Creek Pond (see note below on restrictions)
- Cowan Creek Fishing Pond (see note below on restrictions)
- Retreat Pond (see note below on restrictions)

General Guidelines:

- Residents must assume the responsibility, to themselves and to others, to strictly adhere to these guidelines. If this expectation is not followed it can and will result in loss of participation to that individual(s) until we receive an “all clear” from the responsible authorities to resume “normal” activities.
- Pond use is limited to 10 people or less (see notes specific to the Retreat Pond). Fishermen are expected to be vigilant with this requirement. If other clubs or groups are using a pond the total count cannot exceed 10 people.
- Berry Creek Pond has no catch or limit restrictions
- The Cowan Creek Fishing Pond has a catch and release only policy except for catfish.
- The Retreat Pond catch and keep size is between 5” and 7” with a catch limit of 3 fish.
- The following are the social distance guidelines expected to be followed:
 - Maintain at least a six (6) foot radius between individuals
 - Follow good hygiene practices with frequent (and applicable) hand washing or sanitizing
 - Avoid groups or gatherings of 10 or more people
 - Do not share items of any kind
 - Stay at home if sick
- The CA pavilions and their associated restrooms and water fountains are closed and will remain that way for the foreseeable future. Fishermen are responsible for bringing their own water.
- These guidelines would remain in effect until an “all clear” is announced by the responsible government authority and by the CA Board of Directors.
