Guidelines for Transitional Operation

Revision Date: April 20, 2020

The following general guidelines will apply:

- Members must adhere to the following guideline at all times:
 - ***Maintain at least a six (6) foot radius of social distance between individuals and the limiting of gatherings to not more than 10 people in a small area. Additionally maintain rigorous personal hygiene before and after activity and stay at home if sick.***
- These guidelines will be followed until an “all clear” notice is provided by the responsible governmental authority and notification by the CA Board to do so.
- Activities will be monitored to assure adherence to these guidelines. If these guidelines are not followed it can result in loss of participation to that individual(s) until we receive an “all clear” from the responsible authorities to resume “normal” activities.
- Hand washing (or sanitizing) is expected immediately following the conclusion of any of the following activities.

Sailboat Guidelines:

- Nose and mouth covering is recommended.
- No sharing of boats and/or equipment.
- Troubleshooting and/or repairing of boats must be accomplished while maintaining social distancing.
- Use of the recovery boat requiring two skippers to launch and retrieve: one fore and one aft at all times.
- Skippers are responsible for observing social distance restrictions and calling attention to any violation of by another skipper in the interest of the common welfare.
- A skipper may be asked to leave the sailing area if persistent violations of the rules occur.
- The Boat Leader will monitor activity and be advised of non-compliance of the rules by any person in the sailing area.
- Skippers sail at the Legacy Pond at their own risk.

Aircraft Guidelines:

- The group Leader will monitor adherence to the transitional guidelines.
- The wearing of face masks or buffs while in the Berry Creek Park flying area is required at all times. Wearing of masks protects others so please keep this in mind.
- Please bring hand sanitizer with you to the airfield and apply it prior to touching anything at the field. After touching or using items please reapply hand sanitizer. This includes locks on the shed, the shed itself and anything stored in the shed for members use.
- Avoid touching or handling anyone else's plane, transmitter, batteries or equipment.
- While staging and flying your plane maintain your social distancing.
- All existing rules at the airfield remain in place.

Cars Guidelines:

- We will use the tracks at the Legacy Park and at The Worship Place area only as intended,
- All participants will be reminded of the present rules establish by the CA, that we could lose if they are not observed,
- The group Leader will monitor the number of participants at each event and limit the number to the required number (10) or less.
- If more than 10 participants show up, the group leader will inform the group and ask for volunteers to leave to ensure that the guidelines are followed
- The group leader will monitor adherence to the guidelines
